



Radcalc License Agreement

Radcalc is developed as a tool to assist personnel of the DOE and its contractors and subcontractors, and is **not** intended as a comprehensive basis for regulatory interpretation. Radcalc users accept that they are responsible for the following:

- Understanding, interpreting, and implementing regulations and guidance documents. Radcalc does not evaluate all criteria, especially those that are qualitative in nature. The user must understand and interpret both numeric and nonnumeric requirements established in the regulations, including those that Radcalc evaluates.
- Understanding the technical basis and limitations of calculations performed by Radcalc. Only personnel familiar with the terminology, methodologies, and limitations of hydrogen gas calculations should use Radcalc hydrogen gas calculation capabilities.
- Verifying that source documents used in the development of Radcalc are appropriate and current for calculations the user is performing.
- Reviewing, at a minimum, the Radcalc User Manual (Help Files), Radcalc web site, and any problem reports or other notices made available to the users. A list of known issues is maintained on the Radcalc web site. User input is encouraged.
- Limiting software operation to a single user per download. Radcalc is distributed under a nontransferable single-user license for use on a single central processing unit. User's may not share or distribute the software or passwords without approval as described under SOFTWARE DISTRIBUTION.
- Certifying that the information provided during the registration process is complete and accurate, and updating that information in the event of changes; this information is important as a means of communicating issues identified that may affect software performance.
- Refraining from disassembling, decompiling, modifying, or reverse engineering the software.

Users may make one (1) archival copy of the software provided all limitations and conditions, including this agreement, are affixed to the copy.
